BRETBY PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY PARISH MEETING HELD MONDAY 17th SEPTEMBER 2012 IN THE WRAGG ROOM, ST WYSTANS, BRETBY

12/42 Apologies

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Mrs J Wilkinson, Cllr G Corner, Cllr P Smith

12/43 Variation of Order of Business

No items were identified that required the order of business to be varied

12/44 Declaration of Interests:

No declarations were made.

12/45 Public Speaking

a) Members of the Public and council to comment on any matter

Cllr Ford informed that he has spoken with Steven Smith (DCC) regarding drainage on Bretby Lane and reported that Severn Trent had carried out work to stop the sewage from overflowing. Steve Smith has spoken with Severn Trent regarding the east Staffordshire side of the drains (Moat Bank area) and the original Section 106 agreement made when Moat Bank was built has been referred to. The conclusion of these discussions/investigations is that Steve Smith is to meet with ST (East Staffs side) on 20.09.12 and if ST do not take on responsibility for the drainage then the County Council will instruct that the drains from Moat Bank to Bretby Lane are disconnected..

Mr Toone reported that a camera survey has been carried out on the drains, the results of which confirm that roots have gone through the pipe work and the outlet onto the field at Common Ground Farm is smashed and the ditch is overgrown. Therefore the water will still be unable to escape. Cllr Falder advised the meeting that the landowner is responsible for the upkeep of the ditch and outlet.

The Chairman added that this summer had been a particularly wet one and one of the results was that a 6" deep gully was now in place at the top of Newton Lane cause by the water which had run off the fields and down Newton Lane. Cllr Ford agreed to report this to DCC.

Cllr Ford informed that the Mineral Plan is out for consultation in October 2012 and that there will be various drop in sessions held around the county. The nearest session to Bretby will be held at Repton on 4th October between 11am and 4pm.

b) Police, County Council and District Council members to raise any relevant matter

Cllr Stanton offered the Parish Council a Remembrance Wreath which was accepted. Cllr Badger offered to lay the wreath if a representative from the District Council was unavailable.

Cllr Bridges reported that the drains on Ashby Road are blocked; near to the golf club and roundabout. Cllr Ford agreed to raise this with Steve Smith who in turn can make representations to East Staffordshire Borough Council at the meeting on 20.09.12

7.56pm Cllr Ford, Cllr Stanton and Mr Toone left the meeting

12/48 To receive the Chairman's Report

The Chairman reported that he had made a request for ideas for which the Jubilee fund can be used. This includes an oak noticeboard and some ongoing funding of the Diamond wood. Cllr Mrs Newton concurred stating that the current wood fund was sufficient only to covere the maintenance schedule identified for the next three years, but additional funding would be useful to cover unforeseen routine maintenance or if costs should increase. **RESOLVED** to allocate up to £500 to the Diamond wood maintenance fund.

Cllr Falder also reported that the tree work on The Village Green will be carried out during the autumn and winter.

Cllr Mrs Newton reported that there were a lot of mole hills on The Village Green.

Cllr Badger reported that he had received a parishioner's idea of placing signs indicating the entrance to the village.

The idea was discussed but was considered impractical for the following reasons :-

- it is difficult to identify where the village starts and ends
- that there are a number of various entrances, possibly requiring 5/6 signs which _ would make the signage impractical and expensive.

Whilst the exact amount was unknown, Cllr Ford confirmed that it would be in the region of several millions of pounds along with considerable carbon savings. The future use of the redundant street lights was not known but again Cllr Ford gave his personal opinion that they would remain in situ at least for the foreseeable future.

RESOLVED the proposal is sensible and logical and the Parish Council fully supports the proposal. The Clerk will advise the County Council of the Parish Council's views.
